For families and older adults

240 affordable homes adjacent to George Mason University. Opened in November 2024.

For families

Office-to-affordable housing conversion within walking distance of the Mosaic District. 80 affordable homes under construction.



Fair Ridge Shelter



For people experiencing homelessness

Former extended stay hotel converted into shelter for families experiencing homelessness. Features 85 units and opened in April, 2025.



Little River Glen I & IV



For older adults

Substantial renovation of 120 units of existing senior affordable housing plus the development of 60 new units. Under construction.
